## ACTIVITIES:

### AMBEDKAR HASTSHILP VIKAS YOJNA (AHVY)

With the help of Ministry of Handicrafts, Government of India, New Delhi; Warsi Sewa Sadan organized skill development training program for the 200 artisans of 10 self help groups. They were given the training for 4 months. This helps to stop the migration. These artisans were introduced with new techniques as earlier they were

using the traditional old techniques. As the migration is stopped up to some extent, there are lesser cases of HIV/AIDS and the family struggles.

### **DESIGN DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP:**

By getting the support from the Ministry of Handicrafts, Government of India, New Delhi, Warsi Sewa Sadan organized the design development workshop in the direction of NIFG designer Mr. Akur Khare. The artisans of village Isavur of block Badhapur district Kannauj were made trained in various international designs. The samples of these designs were appreciated by the exporters of New Delhi and Jaipur. The samples were sent and the responses are yet to get but we expect that the result will be good and this will result in speedy development for the artisans in this area.

### **WOMEN EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PROGRAM:**

Warsi Sewa Sadan organized training for 30 participants in soft toys trade at block Jalalabad of district Kannauj with the support from U.P. Women Welfare Corporation Lucknow. Master trainer Uzam Alvi gave the information regarding the making of various types of soft toys. The skill development of the participants was done and opportunities were made available for the employment. All the participants were given certificate by U.P. Women Welfare Corporation Lucknow after the completion of training. A total number of 30 participants were benefited through this training.

### **HEALTH CAMP:**

A health camp was organized on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2010 at block Etawah by the organization through its own resources. The intimation was given in the villages one week in advance. In the camp Dr Shrikant, Dr. S.K.Singh, Dr. P.K. Gupta (Physician) and Dr. Manju Sharma Gynecologist checked the men, women and children and distributed the medicines. Some of the patients were advised to visit the hospital. All were advised to keep neat and cleanliness so that they can prevent from the diseases. Gynecologist Dr. Mamta Singh and ANM Taqseem Begum advised about the pre-natal care, immunization and benefit of mother's milk in details.

### **SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN:**

A signature campaign has been organized on the eve of World AIDS day with the support of U.P. State AIDS Control Society, Lucknow. On the eve of World AIDS Day 1<sup>st</sup> December 2010, Warsi Sewa Sadan organized a signature campaign at college premises with the help of UPSACS. The campaign was started by putting the signature by Collector Mr. A.S.Kushwah and DTO Dr. Udayveer Singh of Etawah. All the present students were pinned the red ribbon and made the signatures. Principal of Karmkshetra College Dr. Mokham Singh and Shailesh Singh initiated the campaign. Ms. Meraj Bano, Secretary of Warsi Sewa Sadan thanked all the participants and said that AIDS is the largest problem of the World and very many efforts are being made on government and non-government level to curb it. The knowledge about the AIDS is the only prevention.

**WORKSHOP ON AIDS:**

Warsi Sewa Sadan organized a day's workshop for ward members and representatives of Municipal Corporation with a support from U.P. State Mainstreaming Unit Lucknow on HIV/AIDS. Mr. Ramesh Menon of UPMU Lucknow addressed them and said that we will try to give you all the information about HIV/AIDS and as you are the elected representatives of the people, they will listen to you attentively when you will spread these messages among them. All the members took the oath that they will convey this message to the public so that the coming generation is free from HIV/AIDS virus. At the end, all the participants were thanked by Secretary Ms. Meraj Bano.

**LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAM:**

On 24<sup>th</sup> September 2010, Warsi Sewa Sadan organized a legal awareness camp at Craft Development Centre, Kannauj with the help of Women Commission, Government of India. The women were encouraged to make legal fight against the violence towards women. The Chief Guest Sadar MLA Mr. Anil Dohre told that in society where women are suffering due to violence, the progress is blocked. The violence against the women is illegal and inhumane but at somewhere the women are themselves responsible as they don't raise the voice against the family violence. This program has put a great impact on the women of the area and they became aware about the legal rights and got the knowledge about the law.

**KISHORI SHAKTI YOJNA:**

Warsi Sewa Sadan organized training program for 30 adolescent girls in Silai-Kadhai at Panchayat Makanpur block Bilhore district Kannauj and also made survey for the masons. After the training of the girls, the certificate were distributed upon completion and helped were rendered them to get the employment. 30 participants got the benefit from this training.

**SURVEY OF CHILD LABOUR:**

A survey has been made in 4 wards (ward no. 06, 07, 08 & 09) tehsil Bilhore district Kanpur nagar up to 15<sup>th</sup> December 2010. A total of 1035 child laborers have been identified who are away from the education and working in dangerous units.

**PEARL PROGRAM:**

On 17<sup>th</sup> August 2010, Warsi Sewa Sadan organized a health camp at Kachhi basti, Chhapeda puliya in Kanpur city with the support from Indo Global Social Service Society (IGSSS) in which the medical check ups were done and the medicines were distributed. The prominent doctors of the city rendered their services and advised about pre-natal care, immunization, family planning and marriage in younger age. Another camp was organized on the eve of World Leprosy Day 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2011 at Vijay nagar, Kachhi puliya and Kanpur nagar. The villagers were given the

intimation in advance and wall writing was done. Prominent physicians, ENT specialists, pediatricians and gynecologist participated in the program. A total of 50 men, 96 women and 70 children were treated and given the medicines. They were also advised about family planning, immunization before the delivery and how to prevent the diseases after the delivery.

### **CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM:**

Under the PEARL project, Warsi Sewa Sadan organized a training program for building the capacity of laborers and Riksha pullers. Advocacy officer Mr.Nazim Ansari from Allahabad and Master Muinuddin discussed with them and advised them about their rights, what type of facilities they can get from the government and how they can avail the benefit from these schemes. Various leaders were invited by the organization to participate in the workshop and advised them to have a union of the labors.

### **EMPOWERMENT OF PANCHAYATI RAJ PROGRAM:**

With the support from ILFS Education and Technology Service Limited; Warsi Sewa Sadan organized in the districts Farrukhabad, Kannauj and Etawah, the capacity building program of the Panchayati Raj System. The training was arranged for a month in each district. The participants were Pradhan from every gram panchayat and members of the three societies viz. water management committee, construction work committee and health and welfare committee. The master trainer from IF& FS education rendered the information about their work. They were advised to arrange two meetings in a year and were encouraged for active participation of the members. Through this coordination program, the officials of panchayati raj, gram panchayat, and district panchayat members were benefited.

Apart from the above program, WARSI SEWA SADAN organized the following days:

### **International Women's Day- 8<sup>th</sup> March 2010**

WARSI SEWA SADAN celebrated International Women's Day on March 8, 2010. International Women's Day (IWD) is celebrated on the 8th of March across the world. IWD is a global day celebrating the economic, political and social achievements of women in the past, present and future. It is a day when women are recognized for their achievements, without regards for divisions, whether national, ethnic, linguistic, cultural, economic and political. This year's theme is "***Empowering Women to End Poverty by 2015***". The employee and officials of WSS were invited to attend the function on the day. They were advised to follow the theme of the year.



### **World Environment Day- 5<sup>th</sup> June 2010**

WARSI SEWA SADAN celebrated World Environment Day on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2010 along with staff. The theme of WED 2010 is “**Many Species. One Planet. One Future.**” It echoes the urgent call to conserve the diversity of life on our planet. A world without biodiversity is a very bleak prospect. Millions of people and millions of species all share the same planet, and only together can we enjoy a safer and more prosperous future. WARSI SEWA SADAN visited the nearby villages and organized the plantation program.



### **World Literacy Day- 8<sup>th</sup> September 2010**

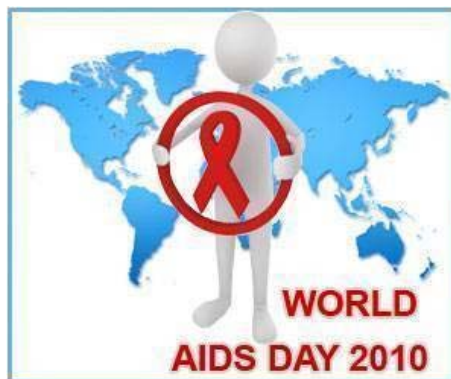
WARSI SEWA SADAN celebrated World Literacy Day on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2010 in its organization. The United Nations' (UN) International Literacy Day annually falls on September 8 to raise people's awareness of and concern for literacy issues in the world. This year's theme is “Literacy is the best remedy”. The Secretary shared with participants that one in five adults are still not literate and two-thirds of them are women. About 75 million children are out-of-school and many more attend irregularly or drop out. However, literacy is also a cause for celebration on the day because there are nearly four billion literate people in the world.

WARSI SEWA SADAN celebrated World AIDS Day 2010 with its staff, volunteers and general public.
